Installing HLA Fusion™ Research 6.1

HLA Fusion Research 6.1 is available for users who have already installed **HLA Fusion Research 6.0** version of the software.

Installation Notes

Please read the following:


- 1. HLA Fusion Research 6.1 is only compatible with computers running Microsoft Windows versions 7 or 10. Windows 8.1 is not supported.
- 2. You must have HLA Fusion Research 6.0 installed before you can install HLA Fusion Research 6.1.
- 3. Make sure that all users log off and close HLA Fusion Research 6.0 before installing HLA Fusion Research 6.1.
- 4. You must install HLA Fusion Research 6.1 on each workstation running HLA Fusion Research 6.0 software, and you must have Administrator privileges to install the update.

Downloading the File

Download HLA Fusion Research 6.1 package file in .zip format from the One Lambda HLA
Fusion product web page at http://www.onelambda.com/en/product/hla-fusion.html.


The desired file will be located on the **Product Documentation tab** under the **Product Description** heading.

- 2. The file will be named **HLA_Fusion_Research_6.1_Setup.zip**
- 3. Decompress the package file on your desktop or wherever you downloaded the file:
 - a. If you downloaded the .zip file, use the Windows right-click menu to extract the file.
- 4. You will now have a **directory containing a single .exe file** named **HLA_Fusion_Research_6.1_Setup.exe.** Open the **HLA_Fusion_Research_6.1_Setup** directory. The .exe file inside should have the same time and date stamp as the one shown in the picture below. If this is not the case, please call **One Lambda Technical Support** for assistance:




Installing HLA Fusion Research 6.1 Software

1. When you are certain that the file you have downloaded is correct, activate this exe file. You must run the installer with Administrator-level computer security permissions. To do so, right-click on the HLA_Fusion_Research_6.1_Setup.exe, then choose **Run as Administrator**. Click **Yes** if the User Account Control message box appears, asking you to make changes to the computer:




If you do not run the exe file as Administrator, you may see this message, and the installation will terminate:




If HLA Fusion Research 6.0 is not already installed, you will receive this message, and the installation terminates:



2. The following **Welcome screen** will now appear. Click the Next button to proceed with the installation:




3. When the .exe installer finishes, you will receive this message:

Verify that the **Build No** (Number) is as shown here:





Uninstalling the HLA Fusion Research Software

Note: Please note that your existing HLA Fusion Research database contents will <u>not</u> be impacted by removal of the HLA Fusion Research application. You can continue to use your existing database with any new version of HLA Fusion Research that you install. See the **HLA Fusion Research Release Notes** or the **Readme** file for the most current database upgrade information.


1. Back Up Your Fusion Research Database (Optional)

- Within the Database Utility window, click the Database Tasks > Backup Database option.
- From the Database Name drop-down list, select a database.
- Click the **Browse Button** in next to the **Destination** field. This brings up a new window where you can select a destination folder for the database backup:



Note: The location you select for the database backup must be somewhere on your local hard drive. You cannot store it on your desktop, in your My Documents directory, or on a network directory.

- 1. Indicate a database Backup File Name in the **Backup File** field. The backed up files are stored with a backup (.bak) file extension.
- 2. Click the **Backup** button. After backup, the following message is displayed.




3. Click the **OK** button. The database is saved as a backup file in the location you specified.

2. Uninstall the HLA Fusion Research 6.1 Program

Note: HLA Fusion 6.1 is an add-on enhancement to HLA Fusion 6.0. Therefore, in order to uninstall it, you must uninstall HLA Fusion 6.0.

1. From the Control Panel, Programs and Features section, select HLA Fusion Research 6.0, then Right click and select Uninstall (see below figure):

Note: If the **Uninstall Button** is not displayed, contact your system administrator - you may not have the necessary privilege level to uninstall software programs.



2. After uninstalling the program, the program folder has been removed -- C:\Program Files (x86)\One Lambda\HLA Fusion Research 6.0.

If this is not the case, please delete the **HLA Fusion Research 6.0** sub-folder from the **C:\Program Files (x86)\One Lambda** folder manually.
